

HKILA Accredited Arborist Assessment Interview

Passing Criteria

The Assessment Interview will be conducted in Cantonese (or English if requested by the candidate).
The assessment shall include questions from each of the following sections,

Section 1 – Tree Identification and Knowledge

Section 2 – Tree Risk Assessment

Section 3 – Safety at Tree Works

Section 4 – Professional Conduct, Ethics and Liabilities

Section 5 – Arboricultural Practice and tree care

There are 3 marking levels for each section



Level A: Knowledgeable



Level B: Marginal



Level C: Not Knowledgeable

Candidates are expected to obtain Level A or B in each section. To pass an interview and to be an Accredited Arborist, candidates must obtain at least one “Level A” AND not more than one “Level C” in the overall interview.

In addition, in Section 4 ‘Ethics, Professional Conduct and Responsibilities’, candidates MUST obtain “level B” or above.



Section 1 Tree Identification and Knowledge

Tree name, flower colour, potential risk due to its species nature etc. may be asked during the interview. Around 10 species photos or leaves specimen will be displayed during the assessment. Passing score is 80% questions answered correctly. In case scoring 60 to 70%, several extra questions will be asked by the assessor to ensure the candidate equipped with sound knowledge on plant identification. Candidates score 50% or below will be considered as fail in Section 1.

Score	Rating
80% or above	Pass
60 – 70%	Marginal pass (if extra questions answered correctly)
50% or below	Fail

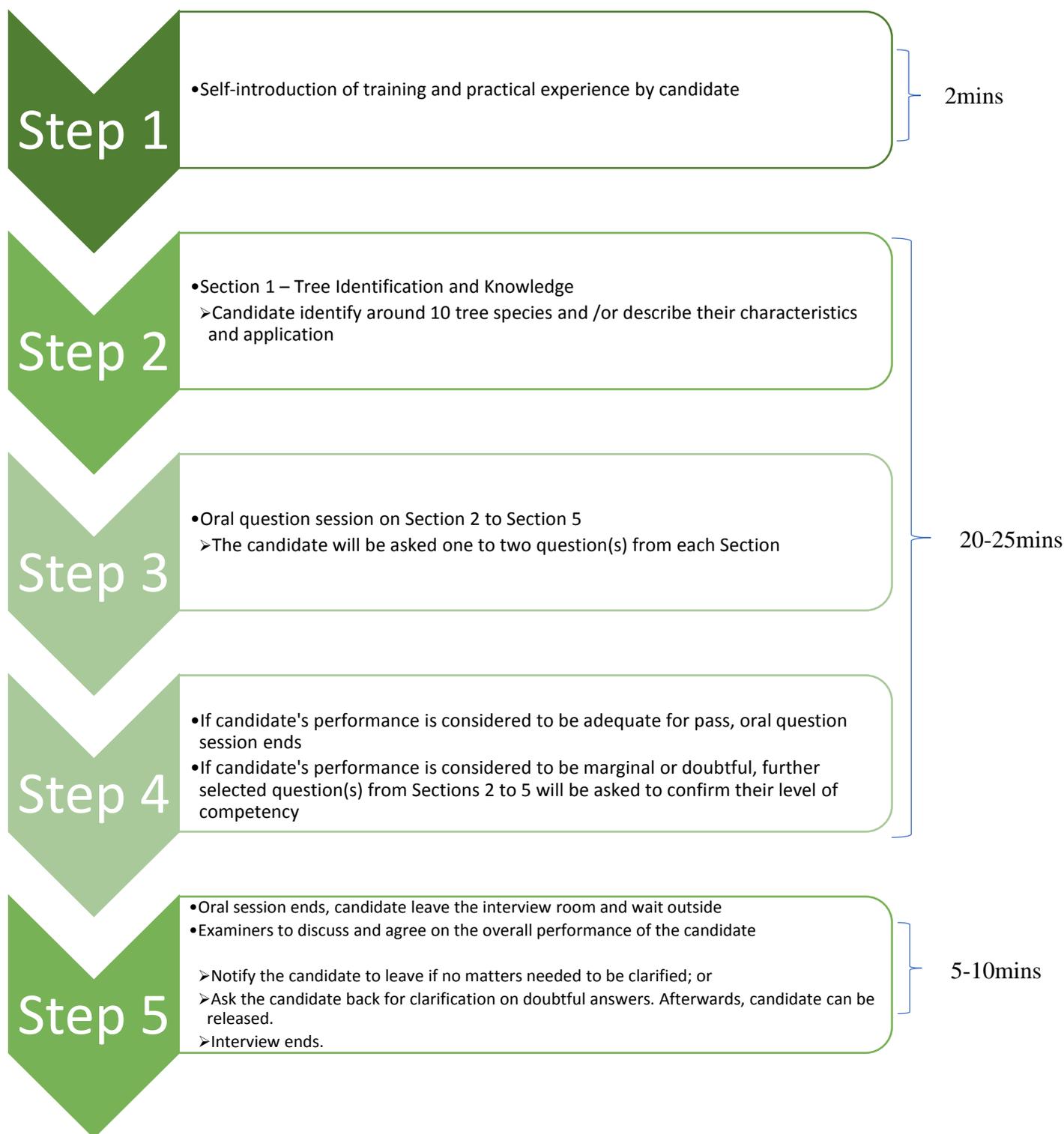
Refer to Tree List for 100 common tree species in planting design, wild woodland, street planting, and Hong Kong native species.

Section 2 to Section 5

Several questions will be asked by the interview panel consists of 3 examiners for each section. The panel will assess if the candidate’s arboriculture knowledge and practical experience sound and qualified to be HKILA Accredited Arborist.

A moderator will sit alternatively in between panels if 2 interviews held concurrently to ensure both interviews' content are similar and fair.

Site Rules and Conduct

- The candidate should arrive 15mins before the interview start time for document and ID verification by interview host
- Dress properly. The dress code is ‘smart casual’
- Visitors are prohibited
- Mobile shall be switched off before the interview started
- No food or beverage is allowed during the interview
- Smoking is prohibited in testing area

Request for Regrading Assessment / Appeals

There is no regrading of the assessment. The assessment result issued to the applicant will be final.
