# 2020 PROFESSIONAL LANDSCAPE AWARDS

The HKILA is extremely proud to announce the 2020 Professional Landscape Awards winners this year. All the entries were of very high standards and our jurors from around the world had high praise of their projects. Here is a summary of the adjudication:

The adjudication was conducted in two stages. In the first each juror made a preliminary evaluation of the submitted entries against the detailed selection criteria, in the second they met online to debate the merits of the submissions, and agree on the winners. In a slight departure from previous award exercises, jurors' discussions focused on the specific contribution of the landscape architect to the project. The jurors were impressed with the quality and richness of the work on show, and diversity of scale, type and geographical location of projects. Collectively the entries reflected the technical and intellectual strength of professional practice in Hong Kong and the very broad scope and relevance of work that HKILA members are presently engaged in. After lengthy discussion the jurors selected five projects in which they considered that the landscape architect had exercised exceptional skill in achieving high quality results:

# 2020 SUSTAINABLE SLOPE LANDSCAPING AWARD

The Geotechnical Engineering Office (GEO) of the Civil Engineering and Development Department (CEDD) launched a Landslip Prevention and Mitigation (LPMit) Programme in 2010, to systematically deal with the landslide risk associated with both natural hillsides and man-made slopes in the interest of public safety.

On the occasion of the 10th anniversary of the LPMit Programme, the GEO has organized the “2020 Sustainable Slope Landscaping Award”, jointly with the following Government Bureau, Department and eminent organisations:

- Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department;
- The Conservancy Association;
- Development Bureau - Greening, Landscape and Tree Management Section;
- The Hong Kong Institute of Landscape Architects (HKILA); and
- The Hong Kong Institution of Engineers.

The Award is divided into two categories, namely Man-made Slope/Retaining Wall Category and Natural Terrain Catchment Category, and its objectives are as follows:

- to promote landscaping with ecological and sustainability considerations for natural terrain hazard mitigation measures and man-made slopes; and
- to show recognition and appreciation to the professional teams for their notable contributions to landscape and engineering designs under the LPMit Programme.

Our Immediate Past President, Mr. Tak Wong, represented the HKILA as one of the jurors to conduct the Stage One Assessment in September 2020 and shortlist 5 finalists of each category for the Stage Two Assessment. Mr. Wong had attended the Stage Two Assessment meeting held on 27 October 2020 and conducted the adjudication on the 10 finalists amongst other jurors.

An Online Voting activity was also launched by CEDD in the second week of November 2020 for the public to express support on their favourite entries from the 10 shortlisted finalists. The public voting will also be taken into account when determining the Award winners.

Final results of the Award will be officially released by CEDD in due course.

Congratulations to those HKILA members who had involved in the winning entries of the Award. Their outstanding achievements amazed the organizers and won high praise from the general public. Moreover, the Institute would like to sincerely thank those members who have supported the Award by participating in the submission of entries or contributed to the Award via various channels.



# THEi 師生推廣善用園林廢物 夥拍屋苑實踐「就地堆肥」

雖然園林廢物佔主要都市固體廢物只有 3%，但據估計本港現時只有不足 3% 的園林廢物會循環回收使用，有時園林廢物混有垃圾，普遍一併作家居棄置於堆填區。園林廢物是可降解物質，會產生堆填氣體，如甲烷（沼氣）、二氧化碳等，加劇溫室效應，面對香港堆填區地方緊張，為何我們不多行一步，推動回收園林廢物，將廢物化作「春泥」？

## 計劃簡介

雖然園林廢物佔主要都市固體廢物只有 3%，但據估計本港現時只有不足 3% 的園林廢物會循環回收使用，有時園林廢物混有垃圾，普遍一併作家居棄置於堆填區。園林廢物是可降解物質，會產生堆填氣體，如甲烷（沼氣）、二氧化碳等，加劇溫室效應，面對香港堆填區地方緊張，為何我們不多行一步，推動回收園林廢物，將廢物化作「春泥」？

政府近年已著手解決相關問題，如環境局早於 2014 年已推出《香港廚餘及園林廢物計劃 2014 - 2022》（《計劃》）時，就園林廢物問題推動源頭減廢、鼓勵分類及收集，並開展研究最妥善處理園林廢物的方法。《計劃》推行後各政府部門按步落實，如康樂及文化事務署會將部分園林廢物送往環保署轄下的動物廢料堆肥廠製作堆肥；環保署又為社區提供天然聖誕樹及桃花的收集及循環再造服務。另外，為回應處理大型園林廢物的需要，環保署將在屯門建設臨時園林廢物處理中心，將大型園林廢物轉化成有用物料。

大部份日常產生的園林廢物，如草屑、樹葉、樹枝、切花、節日植物、木頭等，雖然輕但體積較大，回收時造成一定的運輸費用。業界及普羅大眾對「就地堆肥」或妥善處理園林廢物認識較少，亦缺乏器材如碎枝機、堆肥箱等和相關技術善用園林廢物。

筆者為 THEi 園藝樹藝及園境管理（榮譽）理學士課程導師，曾指導學生的畢業論文，探討市民對園林廢物回收及循環再造態度。問卷調查於 2018 年進行，訪問超過 200 位市民，研究結果顯示香港市民樂意推動環保，近八成（77%）受訪者關注園林廢物的處理設施是否符合環保原則，其次再關注是否合乎成本效益（54%）。值得注意的是，有 53.0% 的受訪者不拒絕在其社區內設立園林廢物回收及循環處理設施，反對在附近設立設施的人僅佔 28.2%，可見「就地堆肥」可推動的潛力頗大。

2019 年 11 月 THEi 環境及設計學院獲環境及自然保育基金撥款資助，推動「環保基金園林廢物新角度 - 私人屋苑先導計劃」，教育屋苑物業管理、綠化管理人員和市民大眾，鼓勵社區展開園林廢物回收再造。先導計劃為本地三個私人屋苑（大角咀海桃灣、屯門蟠龍半島及寶琳疊翠軒）提供堆肥箱、碎枝機等器材，並舉辦工作坊提供技術支援，協助他們進行「就地堆肥」，落實可持續園林廢物管理，同時亦透過網上講座教育公眾有關園林廢物管理的重要。

## THEi 與三屋苑合作 實踐「就地堆肥」

「就地堆肥」步驟簡單，只需將回收到的樹枝、較大塊的樹葉和修剪植物等放入碎枝機切碎，再放入堆肥箱混合適量的泥土和水，控制濕度、溫度和碳氮比，靜待數月至有機園林物料自行分解成肥料，即可用於屋苑的綠化空間。現時不少綠化項目常用黃花沙，含腐殖質較少，回收園林廢物製成的堆肥，可增加泥土儲水力，能有效保存土壤中的養份，促進有益微生物生長，減少植物病害。

## 堆肥步驟簡單且成本不高 獲居民支持

THEi 園藝樹藝及園境管理（榮譽）理學士學生何邁及許信揚，有份協助屋苑利用園林廢物「就地堆肥」，他們會定期到屋苑檢視堆肥進度，活用植物分類學、植物營養，以及土壤與環境等知識。信揚指：「利用園林廢物堆肥對大眾來是新鮮事，合適的溫度和濕度是確保微生物生存、促進堆肥物料分解的秘訣。我們會解釋及示範如何保持物料濕度於 50 至 60% 之間，定期翻動堆肥物料保持含氧量亦很重要。在合適狀態下，物料有機會升溫至 40 至 60 度之間，之後降溫腐熟。」何邁分享：「曾經有屋苑代表發現堆肥箱內長出紅色菇菌，十分驚訝，後來我們解釋這只是分解過程中培養出來的正常真菌，終令他舒一口氣。」二人指計劃除讓他活用學科專業知識外，亦提升其溝通、解難等日後職場常用的技巧，「如我們會就屋苑的回收及堆肥設施擺放位置和人手安排等提供建議，亦積極監察進展和解決實行時出現的問題，鞏固項目管理的技能。」

蟠龍半島物業及設施經理葉先生指其屋苑綠化空間多，日常產生不少園林廢物，都是連同其他家居垃圾運往堆填區。他說：「相反『就地堆肥』只需極少額外水、電、人手等開支，設施佔地不多，亦無造成衛生問題。住戶非常支持此計劃，甚至主動提供家居的園林廢物用作堆肥。」另一參與屋苑海桃灣現已成功製成三箱堆肥，重用於屋苑園圃種植，稍後會分派住戶自家種植之用及宣傳計劃。

筆者是這計劃的負責人，認為這個先導計劃回收園林廢物進行「就地堆肥」，實現「取於屋苑、用於屋苑」，更可省卻棄置園林廢物的運輸成本，同時亦推動環保教育，提升市民大眾環保意識。

筆者認為政府和業界亦可考慮積極集中處理較大型、質優的樹幹，將廢物升級再造成為再造木工藝品和傢俬等，亦可探討多元化出路，如生物炭、燒烤炭、木碎覆蓋物、木膠板、菇菌植料、木酢液等產品。要增加園林廢物再造，是要社會不同界別參與，除政府外，還有私人界別如住宅、商業大廈等。非牟利機構及教育機構可提供園林廢物管理和堆肥生產的短期課程等。另外亦可考慮資助更多住宅及商業物業，推動「就地堆肥」措施。

羅敏儀博士在香港大學獲得博士學位，她的博士論文研究綠化地帶及市區的時態變化及其變化的景觀生態影響。她亦研究利用具觀賞價值的本地植物物種，及選擇品種的研究工作。她還對如何將綠色屋頂和垂直綠化轉化為具有低維護需求和生物多樣性熱點十分感興趣。她最近推動先導計劃回收園林廢物進行「就地堆肥」，及堆肥、生物炭、木碎覆蓋物用於本地園藝種植的可行研究。



# 桃李梅杏櫻

是桃、是梅、還是李？春季外出賞花是總是聽到別人對花朵的身份爭論不休，常聽到人說『桃紅李白』，但反過來問到底有沒有白色的桃和紅色的李呢？桃、李、梅、杏、櫻同屬薔薇科 *Rosaceae* 李亞科 *Prunoideae* 的植物，有著相似的特徵，花瓣和萼片均大形，喬木或灌木，枝髓部堅實，花柱頂生。根據目前中國大陸所採用的分類模式它們被歸入不同的屬，分別為桃屬 *Amygdalus*、李屬 *Prunus*、杏屬 *Armeniaca* 和櫻屬 *Cerasus*。雖然它們的花朵乍眼看來十分相似，但其實可以依據開花時的形態作出分辨。以下是一些常見的李亞科成員，在春季綻放有著奪目的外表。

## 桃屬 *AMYGDALUS*

花 1 - 2 朵，常無柄，稀有柄；花先葉開

桃花 *Amygdalus persica* 是春節常見的花卉，經人工栽培亦產生了有不少外型獨特的品種。除了桃花以外，榆葉梅 *Amygdalus triloba* 亦是桃屬常見的成員之一。



碧桃  
花紅色、複瓣



灑金碧桃 / 源平桃  
一朵花紅白或粉白相間或一個枝條上兼有紅色及白色的花



帚桃 / 塔型碧桃 / 龍柱碧桃  
株形開張度小，分枝直立，花有白色、粉色等



山桃  
野生的桃花品種，單瓣、花色有淡粉或白粉



白碧桃  
花白色、複瓣



菊花桃  
重瓣，花瓣窄，形似菊花，深粉色



榆葉梅  
落葉灌木，春季先花後葉，花粉紅色，1-2朵生於葉腋

## 李屬 *PRUNUS*

花單生或 2 - 3 朵簇生，花常有柄

桃花 *Amygdalus persica* 是春節常見的花卉，經人工栽培亦產生了有不少外型獨特的品種。除了桃花以外，榆葉梅 *Amygdalus triloba* 亦是 桃屬 常見的成員之一。



李 *Prunus salicina*  
花白色，先葉開放，花常以 3 朵簇生



紫葉李 / 櫻桃李 *Prunus cerasifera*  
葉深紅色，花單生葉腋，單瓣，淡紅色漸變白色

## 杏屬 *ARMENIACA*

花常無柄或有短柄，花先葉開



梅 *Armeniaca mume*  
嫩枝青綠色，花單生，碗狀，白色



宮粉梅 *Armeniaca mume*  
嫩枝青綠色，花單生，複瓣，粉紅色



美人梅 *Prunus x blireana*  
為宮粉梅與紫葉李的雜交種。葉片紫紅色，花瓣 15 - 17 枚



杏 *Armeniaca vulgaris*  
嫩枝褐色，花單生先葉開放，花梗短，花瓣白色或帶紅色

### 櫻屬 *CERASUS*

花單生或數朵著生在短總狀或傘房狀花序。櫻屬植物可再細分為櫻亞屬及矮生櫻亞屬，櫻亞屬的植物品種種類繁多，在日本原生品種和經人工栽培及雜交產生的品種就超過 380 個。除了櫻亞屬常見的櫻花，矮生櫻亞屬的植物亦常用作園林綠化用途。

灌木，花單生或 2 - 3 朵簇生，粉白色或近白色

除了上述的李亞科成員之外，梨屬的植物也是在春季開花，但是可以花藥深紅色或紫色的特徵來作出分辨。




